




It works in close co operation with the Indian Navy, the Department of Fisheries, the Department of Customs and the Central and State Police forces to protect India's maritime borders.



सर्वोत्तमं शस्त्रं

मुगल बादशाह अकबर का नाम आए और वीरबल की बात न निकले ऐसा हो ही नहीं सकता। वैसे तो वे वीरबल के नाम से प्रसिद्ध थे परंतु उनका असली नाम महेशदास था। ऐसा विश्वास किया जाता है कि यमुना के तट पर बसे त्रिविंशपुर अब तिकवांपुर के नाम से प्रसिद्ध में एक निर्धन ब्राह्मण परिवार में पैदा हुए थे। अपनी प्रतिभा के बल पर उन्होंने बादशाह अकबर के दरबार के नवरत्नों में स्थान प्राप्त किया था। लोकप्रियता में वीरबल का कोई सानी नहीं था। उनकी विनोदप्रियता और चतुराई के किस्से भारतवर्ष के कोनेकोने में प्रसिद्ध थे। बाकी दरबारी वीरबल से ईर्ष्या रखते थे और हमेशा उन्हें नीचा दिखाने के लिए षडयंत्र रचाते थे। लेकिन हर बार वीरबल अपनी चतुराई से उन्हें मात दे देते थे। एक बार दरबारी कार्यवाही के मध्य बादशाह अकबर ने दरबारियों से एक प्रश्न पूछा। प्रश्न था “बचाव के लिए सबसे अच्छा शस्त्र कौन सा है?” एक एक कर दरबारियों ने इस प्रश्न का उत्तर दिया। किसी ने तलवार कहा, किसी ने भाला, किसी ने तीर, कमान कहा, किसी ने चाकू। जब वीरबल की बारी आई तो वे बोले “जहाजिहाज के विचार से मुसीबत में जो हाथ में हो, वही सबसे अच्छा शस्त्र होता है।” वीरबल का उत्तर सुन दरबारी उनका मजाक उड़ाने लगे। अकबर भी उनके उत्तर के संतुष्ट नहीं हुए। वीरबल उस दिन तो अपमान का घूँट पीकर रह गए लेकिन अपनी बात सही साबित करने का मौका बहुत जल्दी ही उनके हाथ लग गया।

बादशाह अकबर अक्सर भेष बदलकर नगर भ्रमण पर निकला करते थे। वीरबल भी उनके साथ ही होते थे। एक दिन इसी तरह वे दोनों नगर भ्रमण पर निकले। वे एक तंग गली से पैदल गुजर रहे थे तभी एक मतवाला हाथी उस गली में आ गया। उस हाथी को देख अकबर डर गए। उस समय उनके पास एक तलवार थी, लेकिन इतने बड़े हाथी के सामने वह किसी काम की नहीं थी। उन्हें अपने बचाव का कोई रास्ता नहीं सूझ रहा था। गली इतनी तंग थी कि वहाँ भाग पाना लगभग नामुमकिन था। उस गली में एक किनारे पर एक छोटा सा पिल्ला बैठा हुआ था। जब वीरबल की नज़र उस पर पड़ी तो उन्होंने उसे उठाया और हाथी के ऊपर फेंक दिया। इस तरह हाथी के ऊपर उछाल दिए जाने पर पिल्ला डर गया। उसने हाथी की सूँठ को कसकर पकड़ लिया। पिल्ले की इस हरकत पर हाथी भी घबरा गया और अपनी सूँठ झटकने लगा। हाथी के सूँठ झटकने पर पिल्ला सूँठ से फिसलने लगा और स्वयं को गिरने से बचाने के लिए उसने अपने पंजे और दाँत हाथी की सूँठ पर गड़ा दिये। हाथी विलंबिता उठा और सूँठ को झटकते हुए पलटकर गली से बाहर भागने लगा हाथी के गली से बाहर भागने पर अकबर को चैन आया। पसीना पोंछते हुए जब उन्होंने वीरबल को देखा तो वीरबल मुस्कुरा रहे थे। अकबर वीरबल की मुस्कराहट का अर्थ समझ नहीं पाए और पूछ बैठे “वीरबल, ऐसी संकट की घड़ी में भी तुम क्यों मुस्कुरा रहे हो?”
