From a modest beginning as Vajra Nursery School, started by Mrs Sita Rawley, W/O Lt Gen HC Rawley, PVSM, AVSM, MC in 1971. In 1982, the school was upgraded to a High School, affiliated to the CBSE and renamed Vajra Army School. In 1988, it was given the name Army School and further upgraded to the 10 + 2 level. The year 2002 saw the institution re-christened with its present name, Army Public School Jalandhar.

The last 50 years have seen APS Jalandhar grow by leaps and bounds in every way, rising to become one of the most well known amongst the chain of APSs across the country. 
