

17 November: Suez Canal became functional on this day in 1869


26 November: In 1922, it was on this day that archaeologists entered the tomb of Tutankhamen the teenage Egyptian pharaoh

THE INDIAN MATHEMATICIAN WHO WON THE FIELDS MEDAL

The Fields Medal

The Fields Medal is a prize awarded to two, three, or four mathematicians under 40 years of age, at the International Congress of the International Mathematical Union (IMU), a meeting that takes place every four years. The name of the award honours the Canadian mathematician John Charles Fields.

The Fields Medal is regarded as one of the highest honors a mathematician can receive, and has been described as the Nobel Prize of Mathematics.

Manjul Bhargava is an Indian Canadian mathematician who received this award in 2014 for developing powerful new methods in the geometry of numbers, which he applied to count rings of small rank and to bound the average rank of elliptic curves".

Manjul is a Professor of Mathematics at Princeton University, USA the Stieltjes Professor of Number Theory] at Leiden University, Netherlands and also holds Adjunct Professorships at the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, The Indian Institute of Technology Mumbai and the University of Hyderabad. He is known primarily for his contributions to number theory. He has won many other international awards for his findings, including the Padma Bhushan awarded to him by the Government of India in 2015.
